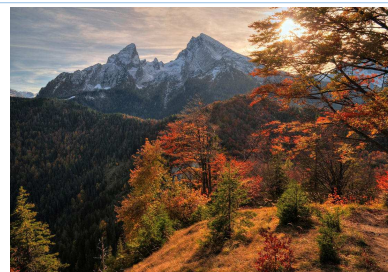

#### Covid Vaccines

City Wide Health will be offering the Covid vaccine to all our eligible patients this autumn. When we have more details we will let you know.

#### Eligible Patients:

- ♦ adults aged 75 years and over
- ♦ residents in a care home for older adults
- ♦ individuals aged 6 months and over who are immunosuppressed, as defined in tables 3 and 4 of the COVID-19 chapter of the Green Book, the UK Health Security Agency's information on immunisation against infectious dis-

## Flu Jabs

### The following eligible patients can be vaccinated from 01/09/25:

- ♦ pregnant women
- ♦ all children aged 2 or 3 years on 31 August 2025
- ♦ those aged 6 months to under 18 years in clinical risk groups

### The following eligible patients can be vaccinated from 01/10/25:

- ♦ 65 years and over (including those who are 64 but will be 65 on or before 31 March 2026)
- ♦ those aged 18 years to under 65 years in clinical risk groups (
- ♦ those in long-stay residential care homes
- ♦ carers in receipt of carer's allowance, or those who are the main carer of an elderly or disabled person
- ♦ close contacts of immunocompromised individuals
- ♦ frontline workers

Kirkbymoorside Surgery will be contacting all eligible patients to book in for a flu jab from the week commencing 01/09/25.

We have clinics running from 16/9/25 for those patients who we can vaccinate from 01/09/25

The following clinic dates have been set up for all other patients:

1st October 2025

3rd October 2025

4th October 2025

We have to buy flu jabs 12 months in advance so please make sure you get your flu vaccine at the surgery. We have bought them for you and they will go to waste if you don't.

All housebound patients will be given their flu vaccine by City Wide Health alongside their covid vaccine if they choose to have it.
